A Renewal of Hope, Purpose, and Transformation

Jose's childhood was a nightmare. He experienced such vile abuse that authorities removed him from his home and placed him in a protective facility. But there, where he should have been safe, he was abused again. The effects were catastrophic to him — to his spirit and psyche — and he understandably suffered from mental-health challenges.

"I stopped trusting people and I had a lot of rage," Jose recalls. "I shut myself away and isolated myself from everyone. I was overwhelmed with anxiety when I was around too many people."

In that state of mind, it's no wonder that Jose struggled to hold down a job. *"I always felt like I was tumbling down the side of a mountain and I couldn't grab onto anything to stop the fall."*

His issues grew so severe, he became suicidal. He cycled in and out of homelessness and psychiatric hospitals. After he recently experienced a stroke, he knew he needed help ...

Finding a Solid Foundation to Rebuild His Life

Asking for help is never easy, but Jose knew he needed help to deal with the demons of his past. He was also running out of money and didn't want to be on the streets. That's why he finally chose to come to Buffalo City Mission.

"It was hard at first because there are so many people," he says. Little by little, though, he made progress. "The principles I'm learning here are bearing fruit. They're helping me build a solid foundation. I'm discovering a sense of purpose I didn't have before, and I'm learning about discipline and responsibility."

He continues, *"For the first time, I feel like I've finally found something to grab onto so I won't fall farther down the mountain."*

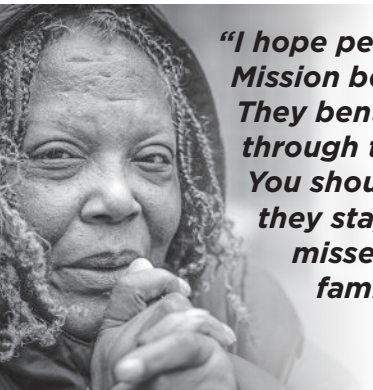
This Christmas, Jose knows his life will never be the same. He's even learning IT and computer skills and plans to start working again!

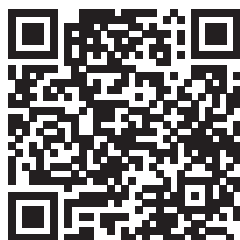
